RENOVATION UPDATE

Now that the front steps, new windows, new front doors, and Centre Street doors have been completed, we have moved on to other areas to be renovated. Here is the update on what has been done to date.

In the downstairs kitchen, a new floor has been installed. Quarry tiles were selected. The old stoves have been removed, and new stoves are in and up and running. Thank you to the Women's Association for their donation towards the stoves. A fire suppression hood installation, required by fire regulations, has also been completed over the stoves. Painting is in process. Once the painting is completed, the cove base will be installed around the room. Check out how great it looks!

A new storage area has been built in the classroom (downstairs behind the kitchen). The walls have been painted, and a chair rail added. Thank you to all those who assisted with the renovations.

Emergency lights and exit signs, as required by the Fire Marshal, were installed at two exits in the sanctuary. Our thanks to Ed Parkin for his donation of time and equipment.

Our church is a work in progress! Next on the horizon, the Trustees are looking into Chapel renovations, a handicapped-accessible bathroom, and much-needed sound system for the sanctuary.
