YOUTH NEWS...

Lauren here, from the Youth ministry corner of our church. As a Youth Director, I take seriously the commandment in Matthew chapter 28. Christ has called us in to “Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that He commanded.” When the Greek is parsed, it translates to “In your goings”, the idea that no matter where we go, we are to take Christ with us. With this in mind, our 2016 Summer Triennium theme is Go. Triennium is a youth event, where each church through our presbytery, sends delegates to be a part of the West Jersey Youth delegation. This conference happens once every three years.

Delegates will attend meetings prior to the trip to design our delegation shirts and buttons, get to know their fellow delegates through fun community-building activities, and prepare themselves for the trip. The meetings are mandatory. Students who are incoming freshman as of July 2016 and seniors who have just recently graduated as of 2016 will be invited to attend the national Presbytery Youth conference at Perdue University in Indiana.

Hands down, this is the best youth event we participate in. Students will get to participate and worship with other Presbyterians from the United States and even youth delegates around the world. They will walk away with changed lives and changed hearts for the kingdom of God.

The dates for the trip are as follows:

- **November 1, 2015:** Lauren will hand out Triennium applications for any interested delegates.
- **November 25, 2015:** All applications will be due to Lauren. (Any late applications will pay \$40 late processing fee and might not receive a room with air conditioning. It is in the delegate’s best interest to get the form in ON TIME.)
- **January 31, 2016:** Triennium Delegation meeting at PC Woodbury 3-5 p.m.
- **March 13, 2016:** Triennium Delegation meeting at PC Woodbury 3-5 p.m.

- **May 2016:** Presbytery Meeting to be commissioned. (Date & location TBA)
- **July 18, 2016:** Meet at the bus destination, drive all night to get to Perdue University.
- **July 19-22:** Triennium at Perdue University
- **July 22-23:** Get on the bus, drive all night to return to South Jersey at 1 or 2 a.m.

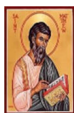
