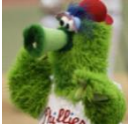

For the first part of the 2018 year, the following donations were given:

- **\$2,100+ for the Spring Rummage Sale.** This money helps the Women's Association with their various projects.
- **\$1,140 for Easter Offering:** This money helps provide scholarship money for our youth to attend camps and conferences.
- **\$330 for One Great Hour of Sharing:** The Presbyterian Church (USA) uses this money to help support people in need of emergency assistance.
- **\$3,161 for the Deacon's Fund:** This money is used by the Deacons for a variety of needs and projects both local and national.
